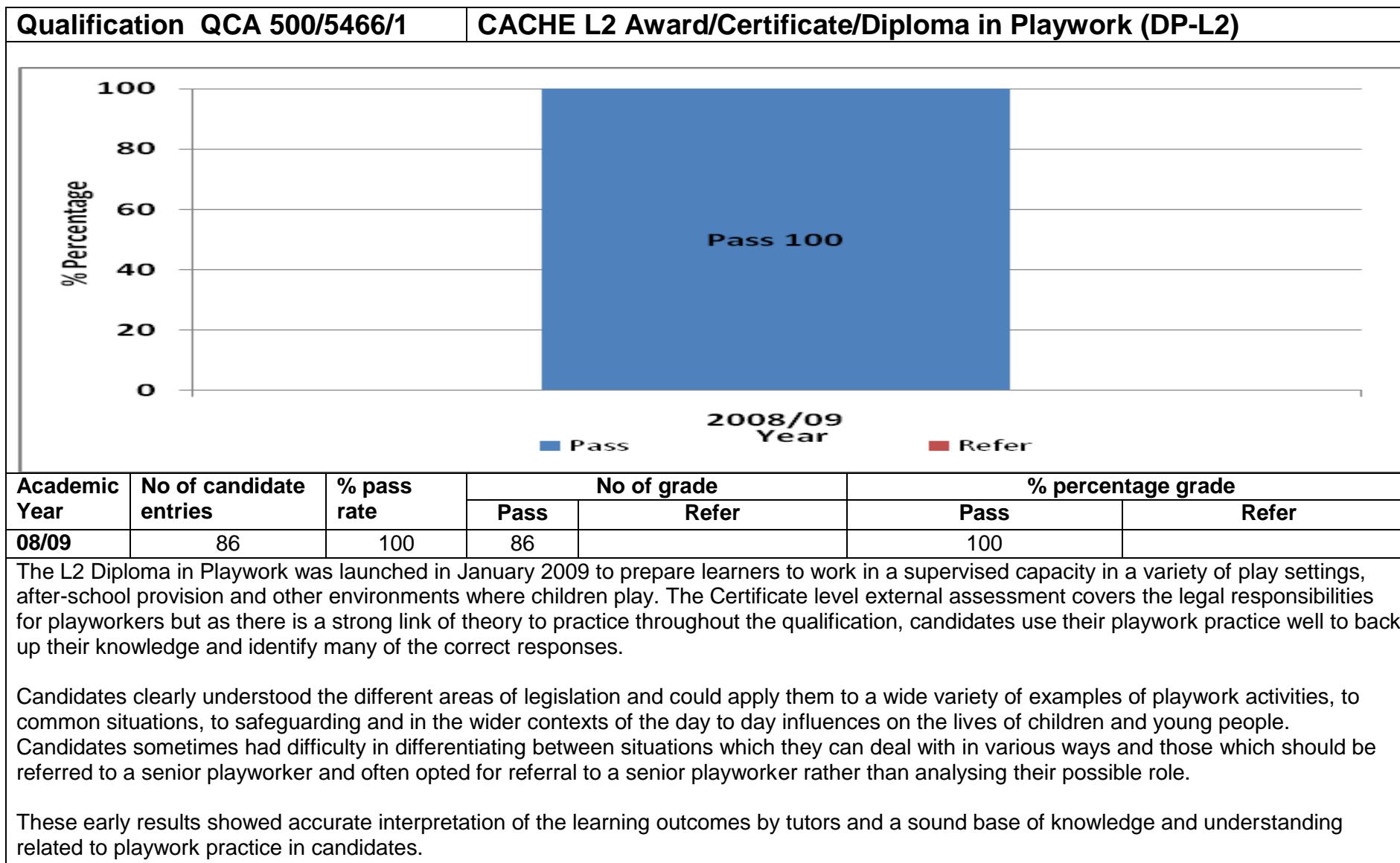

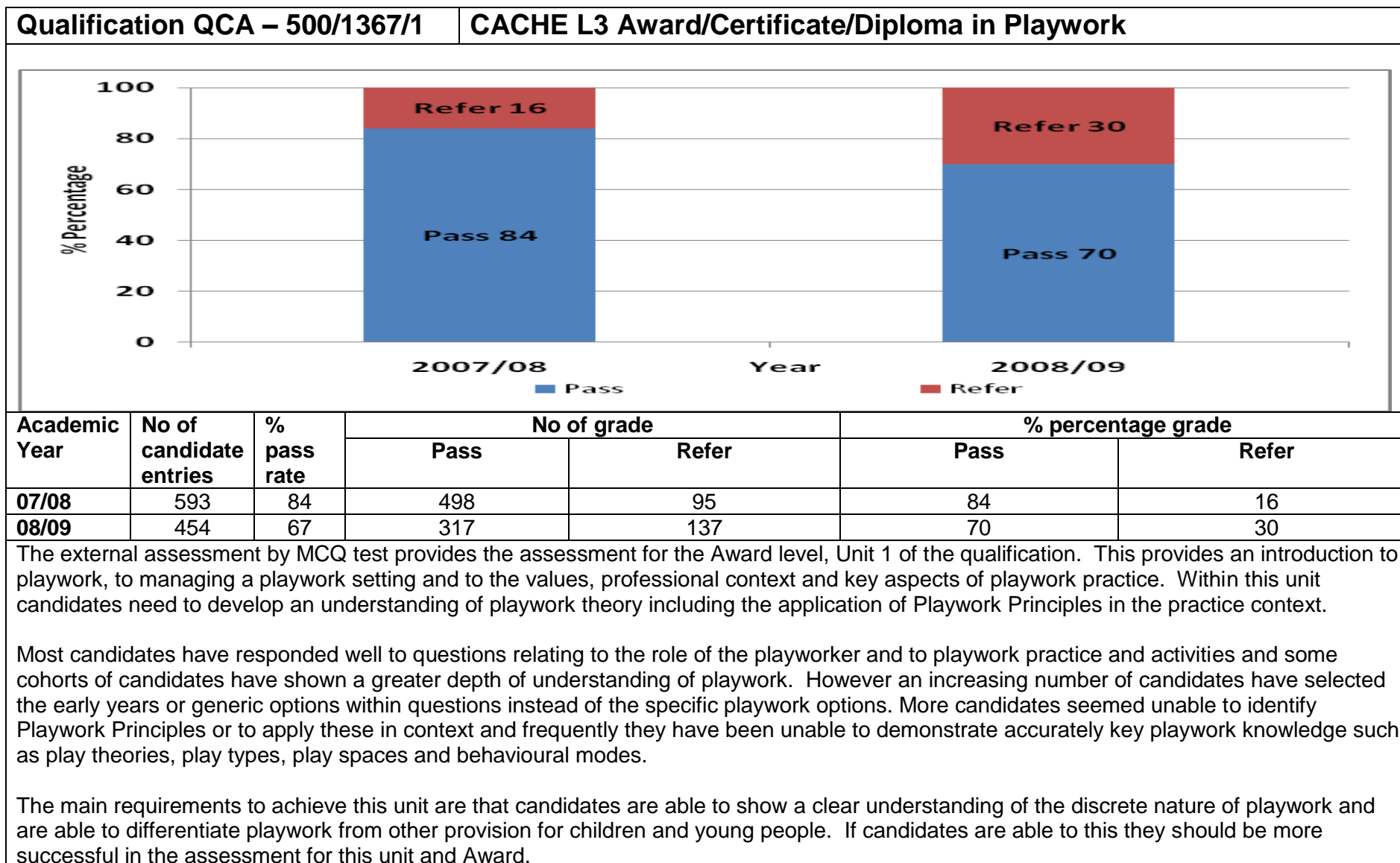
## External Assessment by MCQ test

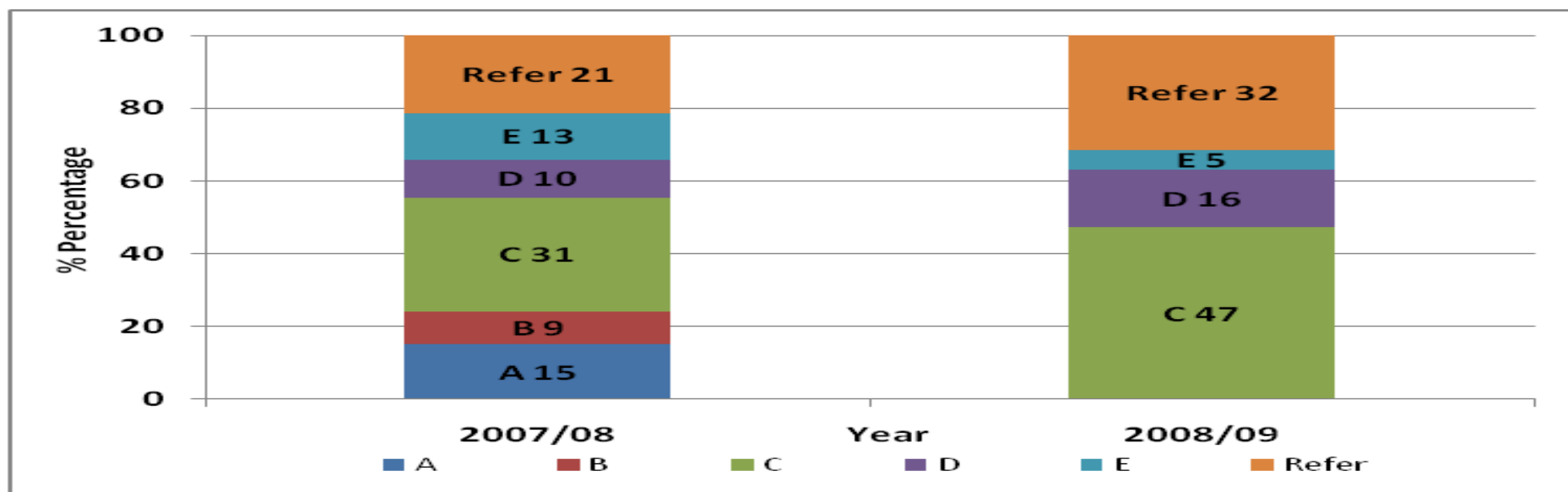

<p>This qualification is no longer available for registration and the small number of candidates is mainly those who were referred initially and who were required to improve only a particular aspect of their assignment; this is reflected in the pass rate. The criteria for this qualification and the errors which candidates often made have now become well known to the tutors who can guide candidates to ensure that they fully complete all aspects e.g. that procedures for both accidents <i>and</i> emergencies are covered.</p> <p>All candidates showed a generally sound understanding of the basic principles of working with children and young people in the playwork context.</p>

This qualification is no longer available for registration and candidates have been those who were completing the qualification. Overall, the criteria for this qualification are well known by the tutors in the playwork field and scripts have been presented at a similar standard to previous series.

Although there have been some weak scripts in terms of sufficient evidence to meet criteria requirements, candidates have often demonstrated some understanding of theoretical perspectives and current thinking in the playwork field. The majority of scripts for this qualification were presented in a logical format and the evidence within the assignments identified good practice in playwork.
