CACHE will pack test papers in accordance with the information regarding sitting times and venues as advised at the time of candidate entry. Upon receipt of materials, the outer bag must be opened to check that the seal on the inner bag containing the test papers has not been broken during dispatch. CACHE must be notified immediately if the inner seal has been broken. CACHE must be notified no later than 7 working days and within 3 working days for the tests that have a range of test dates in one calendar month prior to the test date if assessment material has not been received.
