Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (603/4401/5) (Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification will support learners to develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a range of health and social care settings within Northern Ireland.

Minimum entry age: 16	Credit value: 46
Guided learning hours: 360	Total qualification time: 460

Level 3 Diploma in Health and Social Care (603/4724/7) (Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification will support learners to develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a range of health and social care settings within Northern Ireland.

Minimum entry age: 16	Credit value: 58
Guided learning hours: 374	Total qualification time: 580

Level 3 Extended Diploma in Health and Social Care (603/5355/7) (Adults) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification is designed to provide learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills essential to the health and social care sector within Northern Ireland, and to support progression into Higher Education or the workplace. This qualification is expected to carry UCAS tariff points.

Minimum entry age: 16	Credit value: N/A
Guided learning hours: 1085	Total qualification time: 1395

Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care Services (603/6041/0) (Northern Ireland)

This qualification will support learners to develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a range of health and social care settings within Northern Ireland. There are two pathways within this qualification:

Adult Management – The management pathway is suitable for managers who are looking to progress their career. It is also appropriate for managers who have not yet achieved a vocational qualification at this level.

Adult Residential Management – The residential management pathway is aimed at those in similar roles taking the adult management pathway but the focus is on management and care in residential settings.

This qualification is designed to build the knowledge and skills needed when working with children and young people from birth to 19 years of age. It covers a diverse range of job roles and occupational areas in children's settings, including early years.

Level 3 Extended Diploma for Children's Care, Learning and Development (600/7093/6)* (Wales and Northern Ireland)

This qualification allows learners to work with children aged from birth to 19 years. The aim and purpose of this qualification is to provide a two-year, full-time qualification to meet the needs of learners aged 16 and over.

It covers a wide range of subjects, including: leading professional practice, health and safety and risk management, safeguarding, and developing professional supervision practice.
